PLEASE READ THIS LEGAL DOCUMENT CAREFULLY. BY SIGNING THIS DOCUMENT, YOU WILL WAIVE CERTAIN LEGAL RIGHTS AGAINST FELICIAN UNIVERSITY, INCLUDING THE RIGHT TO SUE.

This “Participant Release of Liability, Waiver of Claims, Assumption of Risk and Indemnity Agreement” (hereinafter “Agreement”) is made by and between Felician University, its Members, Directors, Officers, Employees, Agents and/or Servants (hereinafter "Felician University"), and the Participant,

_____, on behalf of himself/herself, and on behalf of his/her family, heirs, and personal representative(s), (hereinafter “Participant”) in contemplation and consideration of the Participant’s participation in a Study Abroad Program (“the Program”) through Felician University.

WHEREAS, Felician University offers a travel study program in _____ (“Host Country”), from _____ to _____, to qualified students of Felician University, to qualified students of other select Universities or universities, and to other members of the community; and

WHEREAS, Participant, voluntarily desires to participate in the Program and understands that participation in the Felician University Study Abroad Program involves inherent risks not found during study at Felician University’s campuses:

IT IS HEREBY AGREED by and between the Participant and Felician University, as follows:

- 1.0 Participation in the Academic Program:** The Participant has been informed by Felician University that the purpose of this program is academic, not a vacation. Participant further acknowledges that Felician University has advised them of the scope and focus of the Program, eligibility requirements, costs, registration procedures, travel, itinerary, logistics, terms of cancellation, academic contact and credit. By signing this Agreement, the Participant acknowledges that he/she has fully educated himself/herself as to the details of this program and agrees to abide by its terms. It is expressly acknowledged that Participant is not required to participate in the Program. In consideration of the Participant's execution of this Agreement and their agreement to be legally

bound by its terms, Felician University will permit the Participant to enter into the Program subject to the provisions set forth herein.

- 1.1 Participant is required to have reached the age of majority (eighteen years of age) in order to execute this document and to participate in the Felician University Study Abroad Program.
- 1.2 The Participant states that he/she is at least eighteen (18) years of age and fully competent to sign this Agreement. **(Participant must attach a copy of his/her valid Passport as Appendix 1).**

2.0 Waiver of Felician University's Liability for Risks and Dangers:

- 2.1 The Participant understands that there are certain dangers, hazards, and risks inherent in international and domestic travel and the activities included in the Program, including but not limited to risks of injury, permanent disability or death, property damage and severe social or economic loss, which may result from the actions, inactions, or negligence of Felician University, the Participant or others, weather conditions, conditions of equipment used, language barriers, differing social cultures, national and local laws, sickness, strikes, natural disasters, civil unrest or hostilities, terrorist activities or acts of war, and other variables not specifically stated herein, that Felician University cannot control and that Felician University cannot assume any responsibility for any such personal injury, property damage or other loss suffered by the Participant.
- 2.2 The Participant further understands that the above risks are also associated with any activities undertaken by the Participant which are not activities included in the Program. Such activities include, but are not limited to, individual travel by the Participant during vacation periods, or periods of time extending beyond the termination of the Program, or during other periods in which the Participant is not undertaking program activities. Felician University cannot and does not assume responsibility for any such personal injury, property damage, or other loss suffered by the Participant during such times.
- 2.3 Knowing the risks described above, and in consideration of being permitted to participate in the Program, the Participant assumes all the risks and responsibilities surrounding the Participant's participation in the Program and further agrees to exonerate, indemnify and hold Felician University harmless from and against any and all liabilities and obligations for which Participant may become liable while in the Program.
- 2.4 The Participant hereby releases and forever discharges Felician University, to the maximum extent permitted by law, from any and all liability for any loss, damage, injury, including death, or expense, that he/she or his/her next of kin may suffer during, as a result of, or in any way associated with Participant's participation in the Program (including periods in transit to or from any country where the Program is being conducted) due to any cause whatsoever, including, but not limited to, negligence, breach of contract or breach of any statutory duty of care, delay, expense, and/or act of nature.

3.0 Participant Responsibility for Medical Needs:

- 3.1 The Participant understands that healthcare facilities may be minimal/absent in rural/remote areas and that all types of health care, including for emergencies, may be difficult to find. The Participant further understands that the Participant should not expect the same type of health care as would be available in the Participant's home country.
- 3.2 The Participant assures Felician University that the Participant has consulted with a medical doctor with regard to the Participant's personal medical needs such that the Participant can and does further state that there are no health-related reasons or problems which preclude or restrict his/her participation in the Program.
- 3.3 The Participant assumes all risk and responsibility for their personal health and well being. The Participant is aware of all applicable personal medical needs, as well as having arranged for adequate hospitalization insurance to meet any and all needs for payment of hospital costs while the Participant is undertaking the Program.
- 3.4 The Participant agrees that Felician University cannot be and is not responsible for attending to any of the Participant's medical or medication needs, that the Participant assumes all risk and responsibility therefore, and that if the Participant is required to be hospitalized while in a foreign country or in the United States during the Program, Felician University cannot and does not assume any legal responsibility for payment of such costs or quality of such treatment.
- 3.5 The Participant assures Felician University that the Participant has consulted with his/her health insurer regarding the availability of health insurance coverage in the eventuality that the Participant requires personal medical attention during the Participant's participation in the Program. Participant is advised to obtain insurance coverage for medical evacuation and repatriation if the Participant's health insurer does not provide such coverage.
- 3.6 The Participant agrees that Felician University may (but is not obligated to) take any actions it considers to be warranted under the circumstances regarding the health and safety of the Participant, during his/her Participation in the Program. Participant therefore grants Felician University full authority to take whatever actions they may consider to be warranted under the circumstances regarding the protection of Participant's health and safety, and Participant thereby releases Felician University from any liability for any such decisions or actions as may be taken by them. The full authority granted in the preceding sentence shall include the right to place Participant, at Participant's own expense, and without further consent, in a hospital for medical services and treatment, or, if no hospital is accessible, to place Participant in the care of a local medical doctor for treatment. If Felician University deems it necessary or desirable, Participant authorizes them to transport Participant back to the United States, by commercial airline or otherwise, at Participant's own expense, for medical treatment.
- 3.7 Having read and understood this information on healthcare precautions, the Participant has fully informed Felician University of any condition of his/her mental/physical health that might affect the Participant participation in the program. **(Participant must attach a copy of his/her Emergency Contacts & Health and Insurance Questionnaire as Appendix 2).**

4.0 *Participant's Life, Health, and Property Insurance:* The Participant is aware that there are other potential risks in which the Participant may be placed or in which the Participant may place

himself/herself during the Program, which neither the Participant nor Felician University are able to foresee at this time. The Participant is aware that life, health, and property insurance is sold by American companies in order to reduce the financial consequences of such risk.

5.0 *Potential Travel and Accommodation Problems*

- 5.1 The Participant acknowledges and agrees to accept all responsibility for loss or additional expenses due to delays or other changes in transportation due to sickness, weather, strikes, or other unforeseen causes. The Participant acknowledges and understands that Felician University assumes no liability whatsoever for any loss, damage, destruction, theft or the like to the Participant's luggage or personal belongings, and that the Participant has retained adequate insurance or has sufficient funds to replace such belongings and will hold Felician University harmless therefrom.
- 5.2 The Participant acknowledges and understands that in the event the Participant becomes detached from the Program group, fails to meet a departure bus, airplane, train, or other conveyance, or becomes sick or injured, the Participant will bear all responsibility to seek out, contact, and reach the Program group at its next available destination; and that the Participant shall bear all costs attendant to contacting and reaching the group at its next available destination.
- 5.3 The Participant acknowledges and understands that there are risks associated with operating and riding as a passenger in a motor vehicle while participating in the Program and that Felician University assumes no liability whatever for any death, injury, damage, loss, accident or delay resulting from the Participant's operating or riding as a passenger in a motor vehicle while participating in the Program.
- 5.4 All services and accommodations are subject to the laws of the country in which they are provided. The Participant understands that Felician University in no way represents, or acts as agent for, the transportation carriers, hotels, and other suppliers of services connected with the Program. The Participant further understands and agrees that Felician University is:
 - 5.4.1 Not responsible or liable for any injury, damage, loss, accident, delay, or other irregularity which may be caused by the defect of any vehicle or the negligence or default by any company or person engaged in providing or performing any of the services involved in the Program;
 - 5.4.2 Not responsible for any disruption of travel arrangements, or any consequent additional expenses that may be incurred there from.

6.0 *Felician University's Rights, Powers and Responsibilities:* Felician University reserves the following rights, powers and responsibilities:

- 6.1 The right to cancel the Program, or any component of the Program, without penalty;
- 6.2 The right to alter or withdraw any part of the Program and to make any alterations, deletions or modifications in the itinerary and/or academic program as deemed necessary by Felician University.

- 6.3 Notwithstanding, the rights and powers reserved by Felician University, it cannot guarantee the safety of the Participants, monitor or control all of the daily personal decisions, choices and activities of Participants, or assume responsibility for the Participants or other third parties that are beyond the control of Felician University.
- 6.4 The Participant understands that military action, terrorist threats, labor strikes, civil unrest, and natural disasters, as well as other situations which are disruptive to the learning environment and/or the life of and safety of the Program group, may result in an alteration in the Program itinerary. The Participant agrees to accept financial responsibility for himself/herself which may result from such a change in the program itinerary and agrees to follow the leadership and direction of Felician University in the decision to change travel plans.
- 6.5 The Participant acknowledges and understands that Felician University assumes no liability whatsoever for any death, injury, loss, damage, harm, accident or delay resulting from the Participant's conduct as described in Section 7 of the Agreement.

7.0 *Conduct of the Participant:* The Participant acknowledges and understands that the Participant is expected to be a Felician University ambassador of goodwill throughout the time that he/she is participating in the Program. If the Participant is a Felician University student, the Participant agrees to adhere to the rules and regulations as contained in the Felician University *Student Handbook* and all relevant Felician University policies. Additionally, the Participant agrees to comport their conduct to the following standard during the Program:

- 7.1 The Participant acknowledges and understands that each foreign country has its own laws and standards of acceptable conduct, including dress, manners, morals, politics, drug use and behavior. The Participant recognizes that some behavior violates local laws and cultural morals and can affect his/her own health and safety. The Participant agrees to observe and follow local norms of conduct and heed the advice of the Program Director in any interaction with the local population.
- 7.2 The Participant agrees that he/she will not engage in illegal, dishonest, disruptive or dangerous conduct that jeopardizes the safety and well-being of himself/herself or others.
- 7.3 The Participant understands that violent behavior (including, but not limited to physical assault, possession or use of a weapon, threats of violence), will result in expulsion from the Program, without refund of tuition or fees, and to return the Participant to the United States at his/her own expense.
- 7.4 The Participant understands that illegal drugs in any form are not tolerated by Felician University, and any Participant dependent upon their use should not apply. Participants found to be using illegal drugs, in any form, will result in expulsion from the Program, without refund of tuition or fees, and to return the Participant to the United States at his/her own expense. The Participant is aware of the health, safety, and legal implications associated with the use of alcohol and drugs and will educate himself/herself, prior to departure, as to the local or national laws of the host country.
- 7.5 The Participant understands that abuse of alcohol or other legal substances is not tolerated by Felician University, and Participants whose abuse of alcohol or legal drugs poses a threat to him/her, other Participants, the Program or the local population are subject to automatic dismissal.

- 7.6 If the Participant is a Felician College student, the Participant has made himself/herself aware of the rules and regulations as contained in the Felician University Student Handbook and all relevant Felician University policies. The Participant agrees to comply with all rules, standards and instructions for student behavior promulgated by Felician University.
- 7.7 The Participant also agrees that Felician University has a right to enforce the standards of conduct described above, in its sole judgment, and that it will impose sanctions, up to and including expulsion from the Program, for violating these standards or for any behavior detrimental to or incompatible with the interest, harmony, and welfare of the Program, other participants, and local populations.
- 7.8 The Participant recognizes that due to the circumstances of foreign study programs, procedures for notice, hearing, and appeal applicable to student disciplinary proceedings at Felician University shall not apply. If the Participant is expelled from the Program by the Program Director, he/she consents to being sent home at his/her own expense, with no refund of fees or Program charges.
- 7.9 The Participant agrees to uphold individual and group standards appropriate to the cultural setting of the program. If the Participant's actions violate local or national laws and/or Felician University or host institution regulations, or are judged to be injurious to the Program and/or seriously offensive to the host cultures, and/or damaging to the reputation of Felician University, the Participant acknowledges that the Program Director has the right to expel the Participant from the Program, without refund of tuition or fees, and to return the Participant to the United States at his/her own expense.
- 7.10 If the Participant is a Felician University student, the Participant acknowledges and understands that if a Participant violates the terms of this Agreement, in addition to the Participant's expulsion from the Program by the Program Director, Felician University may pursue other penalties, including expulsion from Felician University, pursuant to the Felician University *Student Handbook*.

8.0 Legal Problems:

- 8.1 The Participant will independently become informed of, and abide by, the laws and standards for each country to or through which he/she will travel during the Program, and accepts any consequences of violations thereof.
- 8.2 The Participant also understands that Felician University is not responsible for providing any assistance, legal or otherwise, in dealing with the laws of foreign countries. The Participant acknowledges and understands that should the Participant have or develop legal problems with any foreign nationals or with any government while participating in the Program the Participant will attend to the matter personally with the Participant's own personal funds. Felician University is not responsible for providing any assistance under such circumstances.

9.0 Governing Law and Choice of Forum: The Participant agrees that this Agreement shall be construed in accordance with the laws of the State of New Jersey, which shall be the forum for any lawsuits filed under or incident to the Agreement or the Program. The terms and provisions of this Agreement shall be severable, such that if a court of competent jurisdiction holds any term

to be illegal, unenforceable, or in conflict with any law governing this Agreement, the validity of the remaining portions shall not be affected thereby.

10.0 Assumption of the Risks Involved:

10.1 Knowing the dangers, hazards, and risks described herein, or otherwise associated with participation in the Program, whether foreseen or unforeseen, and in consideration of being permitted to participate in the Program, the Participant, on behalf of the Participant's family, heirs, and personal representative(s), agrees to assume all risks and responsibilities surrounding Participant's participation in the Program including transit to, during and from the Program, and to forever discharge, release and waive any claims against Felician University for any and all liability related to any harm, injury, damage, claims, demands, actions, causes of action, costs, and expenses of any nature whatsoever which the Participant may have or which may hereafter accrue to the Participant, arising out of or related to any loss, damage, or injury, including but not limited to suffering and death, that may be sustained by the Participant or by any property belonging to the Participant, except for loss or injury arising out of the sole negligence or willful misconduct of Felician University.

10.3 The Participant acknowledges having read and understood all Consular Information sheets, travel warnings, and other announcements posted on the web site of the U.S. State Department and relating to the country or countries visited during the Program.

11.0 Other Claims: It is the Participant's express intent that this Agreement shall bind the members of the Participant's family and spouse, if Participant is alive, and Participant's family, estate, heirs, administrators, personal representatives, or assigns, if Participant is deceased, and shall be deemed as a Release, Waiver, Discharge, and Covenant not to Sue Felician University. The Participant agrees to save and hold harmless, indemnify, and defend Felician University from any claim by the Participant or Participant's family, arising out of the Participant's participation in the Program.

12.0 Severability Clause: Should any provision of this Agreement be declared or be determined by any court to be illegal or invalid, the validity of the remaining parts, terms or provisions shall not be affected thereby and said illegal or invalid part, term, or provision shall be deemed not to be part of this Agreement.

13.0 Entire Agreement: In signing this Agreement, the Participant acknowledges and represents that the Participant has become fully informed of the content of this Agreement by reading it before signing it and that no oral representations, statements, or inducements, apart from the foregoing written statement, have been made.
